The Susquehanna River

A Paddler's Paradise

Even though we're called the Endless Mountains, the Susquehanna River is just as iconic as our rolling hills. It weaves among the forests and farmland, rubs shoulders with historic Route 6, and sets a tranquil backdrop for our small towns. You can admire its beauty from roadside overlooks and local parks, but the best way to experience the wonders of the river is to get on the water. From a kayak or canoe, you'll discover the Susquehanna from a whole new perspective.

Adventures on the North Branch

Our section of the river is known as the Susquehanna River North Branch Water Trail. Stretching from the New York border to Sunbury, the North Branch has been named Pennsylvania's River of the Year six times, which is a record unmatched by any other waterway in the state. It most recently received the honor in 2023.

The Susquehanna is also one of the oldest river systems in the world. Formed between 320 and 340 million years ago, this river has plenty of stories to tell. Paddlers can immerse themselves in the rich history, magnificent scenery, and close-knit communities that make the North Branch such a special place.

"The mountains shaped the currents of history, from the Indigenous people that first paddled the Susquehanna watershed and harvested its bounty to today's

summer recreationalists," explained Cain Chamberlin, executive director of the Endless Mountains Heritage Region. "This rugged landscape has defined settlement patterns; religious movements; war campaigns during early America; and industries like farming, coal mining, and natural gas."

Today, paddlers can catch a glimpse of the past at historic sites like the French Azilum, where French aristocrats escaped the Revolution in the late 1700s. Other pieces of the past are hidden in plain sight, like remnants of the old North Branch Canal.

For many paddlers, the Vosburg Neck is one of the most captivating spots on the river. Here, the river forms an oxbow bend, carving out a deep U-shape around the mountains. The area is home to one of Pennsylvania's newest state parks and offers river access for non-motorized boats.

"My favorite day trip is from Meshoppen or Mehoopany [private launch] through the Vosburg Neck and finishing up in Tunkhannock's Riverside Park," said Art Coolbaugh, owner of Susquehanna Kayak & Canoe Rentals. "This is a fourteen- or eleven-mile paddle depending on your starting launch which offers both slow pools as well as faster water, great fishing, and towering mountains through the Vosburg Neck with so many eagle sightings."

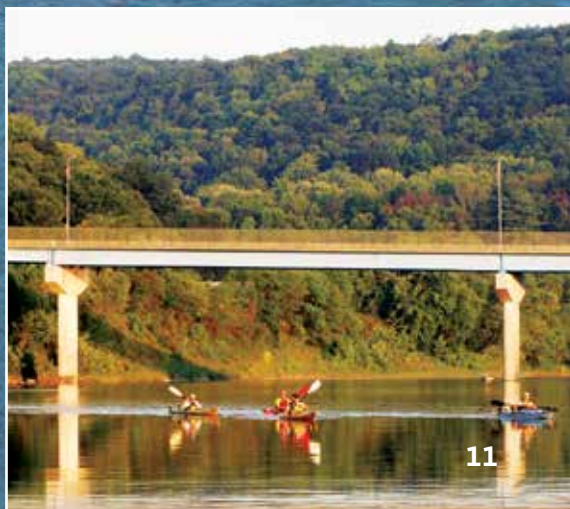
Sections like the Vosburg Neck are so peaceful, you can almost imagine what it was like back in the olden days. Soaring cliffs and dense forests showcase the beauty of the Endless Mountains, and the water reveals views you would never see from a trail or a road.

River Resources

No boat? No problem. Local outfitters like Endless Mountain Outfitters of Sugar Run and Susquehanna Kayak & Canoe Rentals of Falls can provide kayaks, gear, and shuttles for your river trip. They offer a wide range of day trips, as well as fun events.

The Endless Mountains Heritage Region co-manages the water trail and provides excellent resources like river maps, an overview of interesting sites, and annual paddling sojourns for youth and adults. They also manage the 444 Club, a group for those who have paddled the entire 444-mile length of the Susquehanna from Cooperstown, New York, to Havre de Grace, Maryland. The Susquehanna Greenway Partnership also co-manages the water trail. They provide additional maps, paddling itineraries, and regional programs. Visit their website at www.susquehannagreenway.org.



KNOW

Before you go

- Read up on rules and regulations from the Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission. Unpowered boats require a permit to use state launches.
- Create a float plan and share it with a friend or family member. Make sure to include where and when you will start and end your trip.
- Just like any outdoor adventure, pack essentials like a river map, snacks, water, extra clothes, and a first aid kit.
- Check the river levels and weather conditions before starting.
- If you're new to kayaking, try paddling on flat water (like a pond or lake) before getting on the river, where you'll have to contend with the current.
- If you have questions, reach out to local outfitters, river guides, and water trail managers. They're experts when it comes to the river, and they're glad to share their knowledge.
- Always wear a life jacket with a whistle.
- It's safer (and more fun!) to paddle with a group.

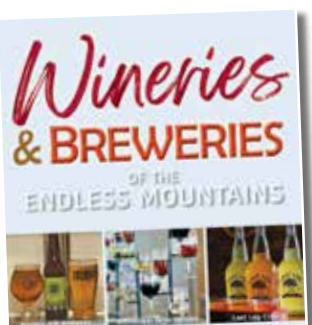

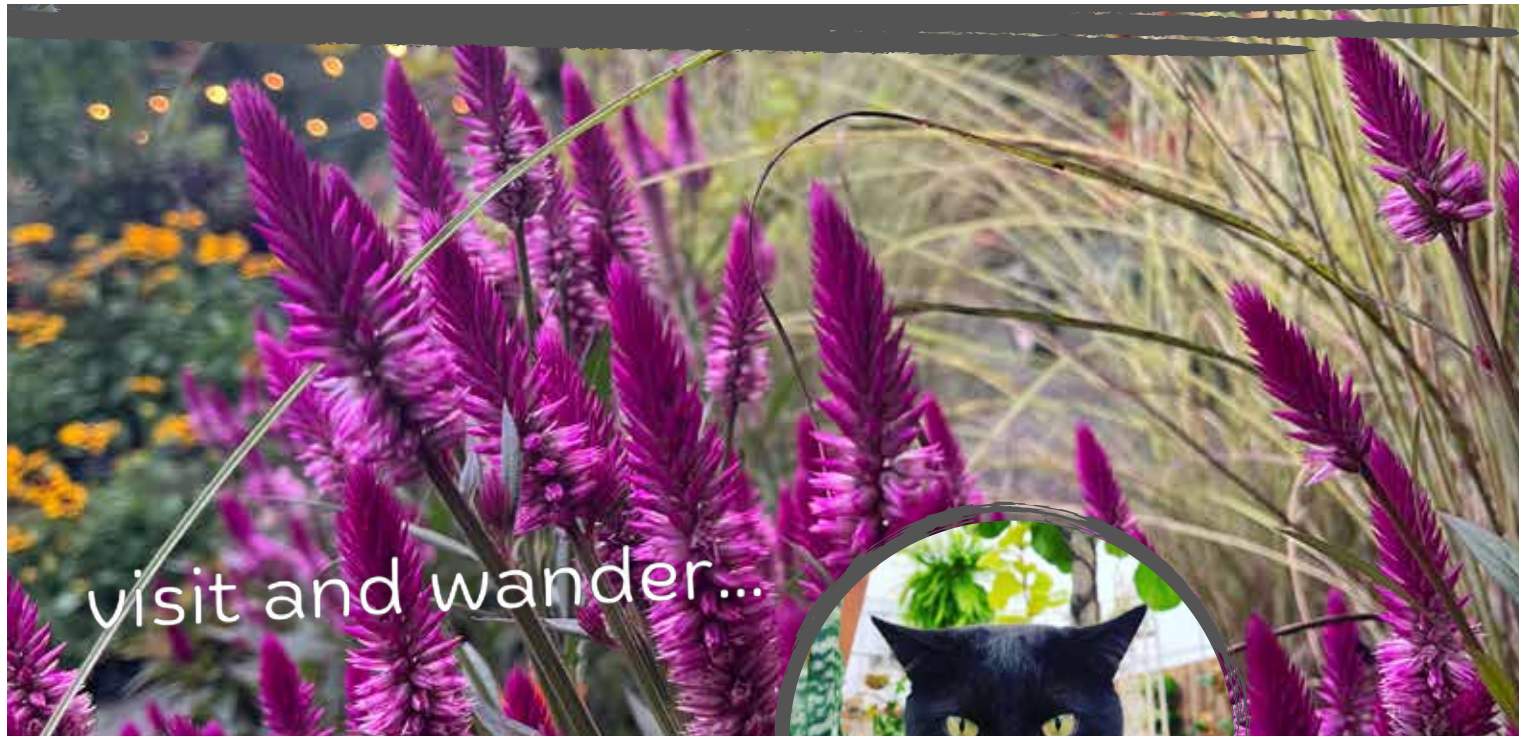

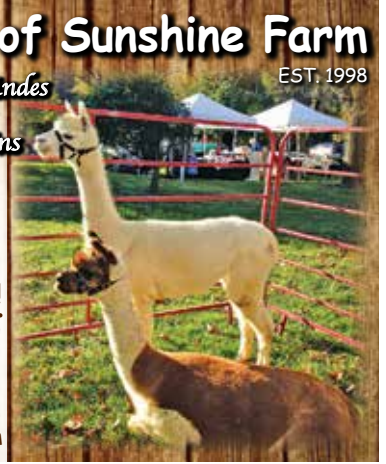

Maybe it's the tranquility of the lake or the beauty of the mountains, but there's something about the village of Eagles Mere that has always inspired creativity. Starting in 1896, people gathered at the Eagles Mere Chautauqua to enrich themselves with education, the arts, and nature. Later, the town's hotels hosted concerts and plays for their guests. The legendary drama professor Alvina Krause even ran a summer stock theatre in Eagles Mere.

Today, the town's artistic spirit lives on through the Eagles Mere Friends of the Arts (EMFA). This nonprofit organization presents professional concerts, live theatre, art classes, and other cultural programs. Summer 2025 marks EMFA's fiftieth anniversary, a milestone to celebrate the organization's growth and set their sights on the future.

"We've been steadily building arts within the community and seeing that it's an incredibly important piece to how the community develops," said Joan Celestino, co-chair of the fiftieth anniversary committee. "I'd like Eagles Mere to be known as a place where people can come and look at art, purchase art, do art, and attend performance art."

Yet, the power of the arts extends beyond Eagles Mere Borough. In a rural area far from the big-city theatres and galleries, EMFA strives to serve the entire Sullivan County community. Whether you're a local, a summer resident, or a weekend visitor, EMFA welcomes you to experience the arts firsthand.

History of EMFA

When Eagles Mere's resorts closed after World War II, the music and shows disappeared along with them. Community members Deborah Reeder and Priscilla Ryan realized that the town missed the performances of the past. They gathered a group of volunteers and officially formed EMFA in 1975. The first season featured two concerts: The Philadelphia Trio and The Philadelphia Chamber Singers. Shortly after, Reeder and

Barbara Sonies founded Music in the Mountains, an annual summer intensive for chamber music students. Alumni still return each year to perform a reunion concert.

Originally, the group hosted events in churches and private homes. Porches and lawns became the stage (when Mother Nature cooperated). The organization ultimately needed a permanent home, and in 1982, they built the David A. DeWire Center in partnership with the Eagles Mere Athletic Association and the Eagles Mere Fire Company. The building still serves as the main hub for classes and events.

EMFA Today

At first, EMFA focused solely on classical music. Although they still pay respect to their roots, they have added genres like jazz, folk, indie, and more to their concert lineup. They also offer free outdoor concerts on the Village Green, which are especially popular with families. With a wider variety of shows, they have grown their audience to new levels.

EMFA has also expanded their programs in live theatre. In the early days, the Savoy Company from Philadelphia presented Gilbert and Sullivan operettas. Then from 1984 to 2011, summer residents Ann Klotz and Seth Orbach organized the Ensemble Theatre Community School, a children's theater workshop that performed several plays per season. Starting in 2012, Harriet Power and Bob Hedley, experienced theatre professors and directors, organized community readings where the locals played the roles. In 2018, they started introducing one- and two-person shows at the DeWire Center, which remain an annual staple.

Another longtime program is Brain/Food, a weekly series that brings people together to enjoy a potluck and share creative conversations. It started over twenty years ago, primarily focusing on book discussions. Over the years, they've expanded to independent films, a poetry night, lectures, and more. Most of the presentations draw from local talent,





such as writers, dancers, producers, and directors. Other speakers share interesting stories from their careers.

Art classes are the newest addition to the summer schedule. Students can try their hand at a variety of visual arts, from painting and drawing to photography and fiber arts, just to name a few. The classes range from one-day sessions to multi-day series, which are perfect for trying out a new skill. Last year, all the instructors were from Sullivan County or the Williamsport area. Instructors receive eighty-five percent of the proceeds from class fees.

“That’s what we’re trying to do — to support the artists and teachers who work here and to help stimulate our creator economy,” said Adelaide Ferguson, EMFA co-chair.

EMFA boasts so many diverse programs that their summer schedule is jam-packed. In 2024, they hosted nearly forty events, over half of which were free to attend. As an all-volunteer organization, their efforts are nothing short of extraordinary.

Join EMFA for Their 50th Season

In honor of their anniversary, EMFA is planning an exciting season.

“For the fiftieth, the board has decided not to try to get one big act and instead up the quality of everything throughout the season. This really fits with Eagles Mere particularly well because so many people come here for small bits of time,” explained Celestino.

The programs are open to the public. You do not have to be a member to attend; however, membership is a wonderful way to show your support for the arts and help EMFA continue their mission.

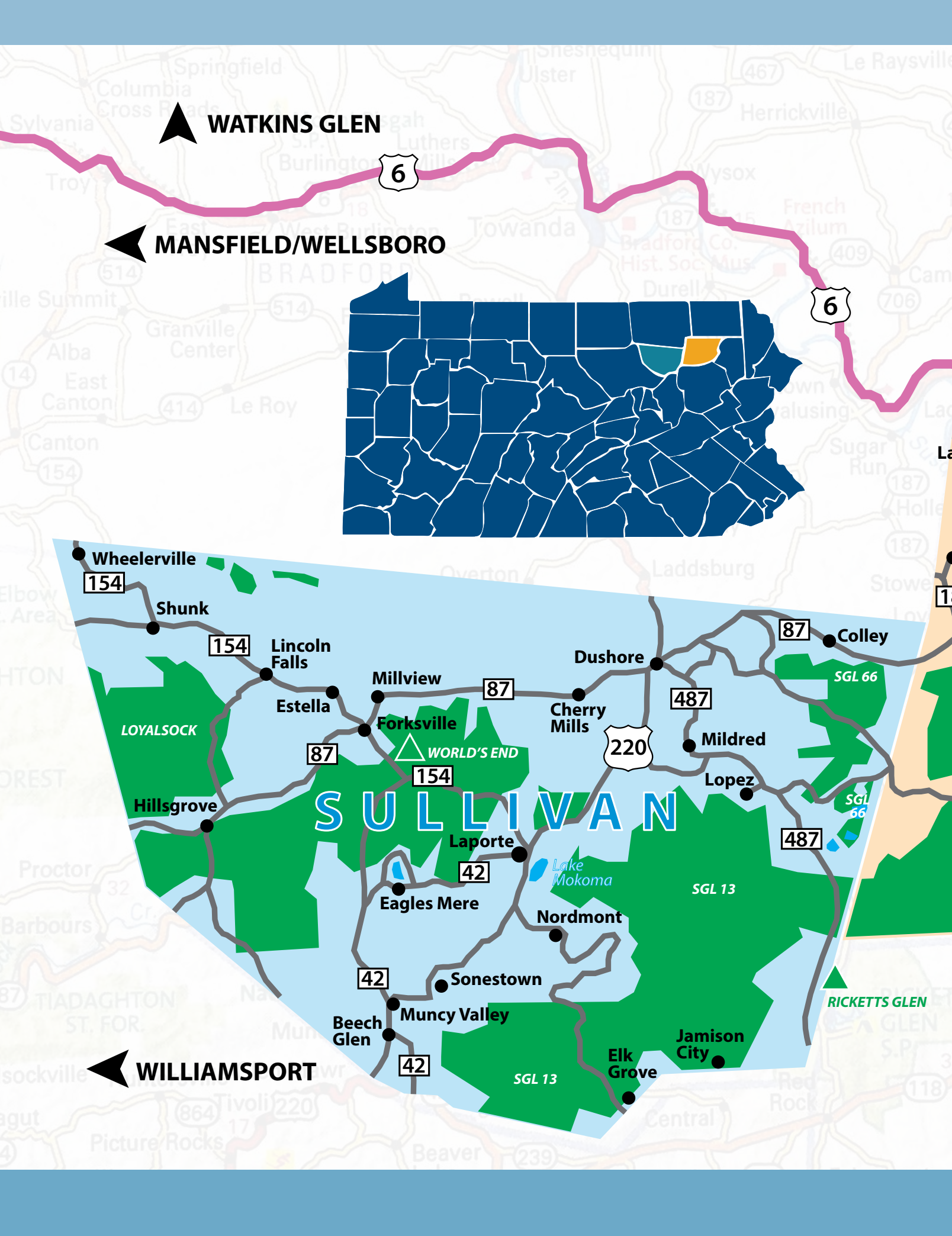

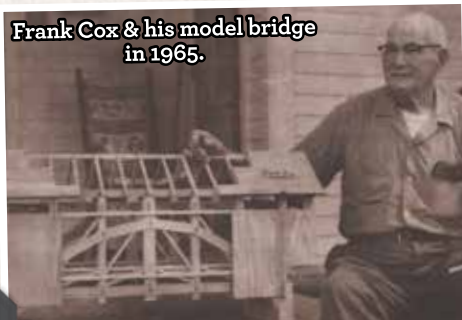
Covered Bridges of Sullivan County



A covered bridge is like a tunnel to the past. When you drive across, you're suddenly surrounded by the intricate woodwork, and the floorboards rattle beneath your tires. For a moment, you're transported back to the days of horses and wagons.

At one point, Sullivan County, Pennsylvania, was home to thirty-five covered bridges. Today, only three remain: the Forksville Covered Bridge, the Hillsgrove Covered Bridge, and the Sonestown Covered Bridge. They were all constructed around 1850 by Sadler Rogers, a prominent builder, farmer, and logger. At just eighteen years old, he carved the prototype for a covered bridge. As he grew older, he created homes, churches, and other buildings throughout the county, several of which still stand today. According to an announcement of his death in *The Sullivan Review* on February 27, 1913, "He'd been known to say that he built houses to make a living, but bridges were his passion."

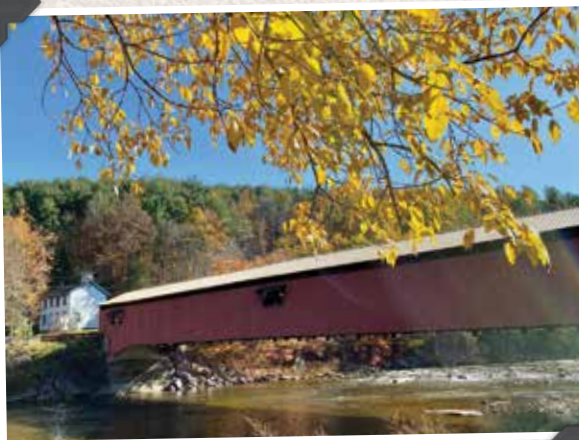


The three bridges use a Burr arch truss system, which combines a classic kingpost truss with thick, reinforced wooden arches that stretch across the length of the entire bridge. The arches allowed the bridges to span longer distances and provided more strength and stability.

At the Sullivan County Historical Society's Museum, visitors can see a scale model of a Burr truss bridge created by Frank Cox of Laporte. The model removes the outer wall and shows the inner structure.

The folklore around covered bridges adds to their intrigue. Some myths claim that they're a haunt for ghosts (one of Hillsgrove's former bridges was named the Bridge of Spooks). Other people find them romantic; they're sometimes called "kissing bridges" because they provided privacy to steal a kiss from your sweetheart. However, their real purpose was much more practical. The roof and walls protected the wooden trusses from the weather and helped them last much longer than an uncovered bridge.

Today, all three bridges are still in use, and they are listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Even though they've endured countless storms (and just as many repairs), they maintain the same rustic charm and rich history that has captivated visitors for 175 years.



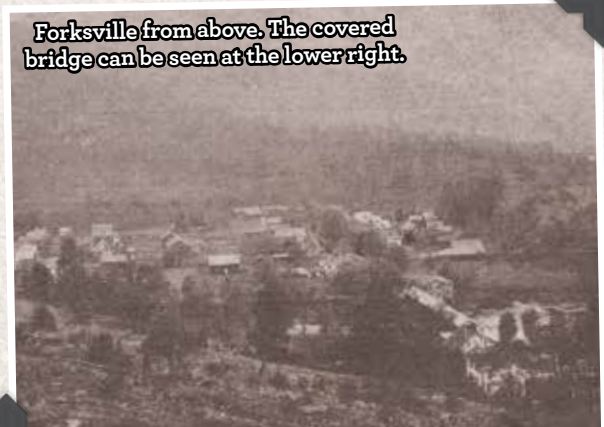
Forksville Covered Bridge

Location: Bridge Street, Forksville

Located off of Route 154, the Forksville Covered Bridge is a familiar sight for visitors heading to Worlds End State Park and the Sullivan County Fairgrounds. It crosses the Loyalsock Creek, where the rolling mountains and quiet village create a scene worthy of a postcard. In fact, it was featured on the cover of *America's Covered Bridges* by Terry E. Miller and Ronald G. Knapp.

A year after completing the bridge, Sadler Rogers built the Forksville General Store. Nowadays, the store serves as Big Mike's Steaks & Hoagies, where guests can enjoy a creekside picnic with excellent views of the bridge.

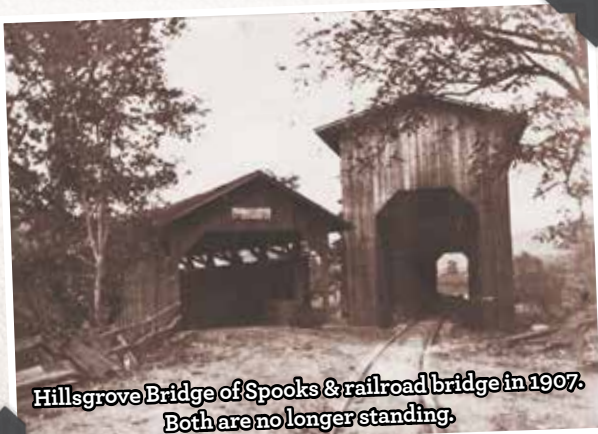
Forksville from above. The covered bridge can be seen at the lower right.



Location: Covered Bridge Road, Hillsgrove

The Hillsgrove Covered Bridge lies about five miles downstream from its cousin in Forksville. It is the longest of Sullivan County's three covered bridges and was also the first to be added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1973.

You can reach the bridge by taking a short detour off of Route 87 and following the peaceful backroads. It sits on a sharp turn, which can make for a pleasant surprise for drivers. On the eastern end (closest to Splash Dam Road), look for the sign at the top, which lists the bridge's regulations from the 1800s.



Sonestown Covered Bridge

Location: Champion Hill Road, Muncy Valley

The Sonestown Covered Bridge (also called the Davidson Covered Bridge) crosses Muncy Creek just off of Route 220. It's the shortest of the three bridges, but it's perhaps the most resilient, surviving extensive storm damage throughout its history.

The Sonestown Bridge originally provided access to a gristmill. Long before PennDOT, it was common for private landowners (or in this case, the mill owner) to pay to build a covered bridge. The roof not only preserved the structure, but it also served as a holding place for customers. If the mill was busy, a wagon could wait in the covered bridge, and the roof would protect their product (such as wheat or corn) from rain, snow, or sun.



View the Bridges

You can easily visit all three bridges within a leisurely drive. The Hillsgrove and Forksville bridges are about five miles apart. The Forksville and Sonestown bridges are roughly fifteen miles apart. Along the way, you'll enjoy a scenic ride through the country and our historic small towns. Please remember to respect private property when viewing the bridges.

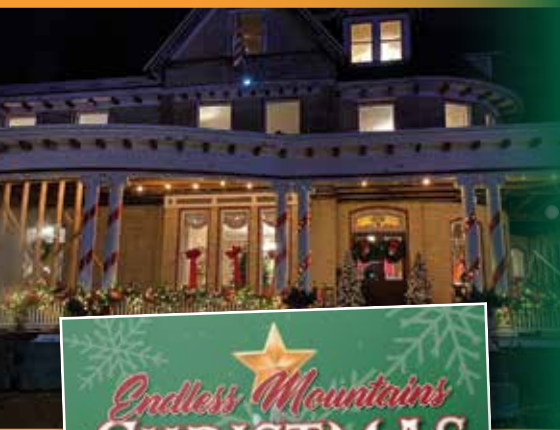

This drive-through display is about two and a half miles long and features favorite characters, two awe-inspiring tunnels, and forests wrapped in lights. Families also love the Christmas Light Spectacular at the Sullivan County Fairgrounds, which adds a bit of sparkle to the long winter nights. And don't forget to cast your vote for the Tunkhannock Christmas Decorating Contest, where local homes and businesses compete to see who has the most holiday spirit.

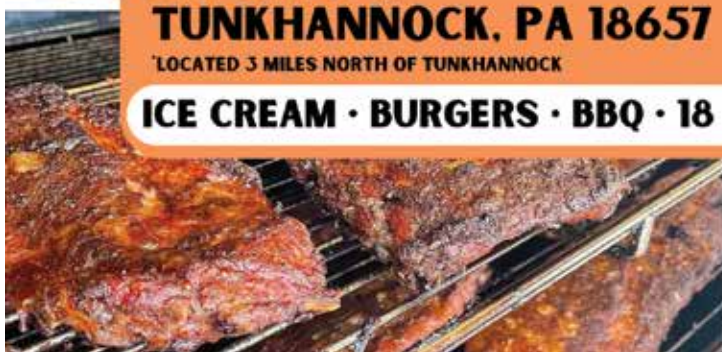

Nicholson Celebrates 150 Years

In 2025, the town of Nicholson will honor 150 years since its founding. The Nicholson Sesquicentennial Committee will plan events every month throughout the year to honor this major milestone.

Many programs feature the town's rich history. January kicked off with a presentation about the six historic hotels that once flourished in town. February celebrated Nicholson's fire department, which was founded in 1904 and will be moving into a new firehall later this year. March commemorated Nicholson's stores and businesses. The committee will continue to launch additional activities each month.

An official celebration will be held on the weekend of Saturday, August 23, 2025, which marks the exact day in 1875 when Nicholson's

incorporation papers were filed at the Wyoming County Courthouse. From August 22 through August 24, the town will host activities like a parade, a period costume ball, guest speakers, lost art demonstrations, local music, a beard/moustache contest, and more.

The committee will also submit monthly feature articles to the *Wyoming County Press Examiner*. Each month will discuss a different theme from the town's past.

Committee member Kathy Steele explained that most of Nicholson's events have focused on the famous Tunkhannock Creek Viaduct,

also called the Nicholson Bridge. However, the sesquicentennial provides a chance to highlight the town itself, including the people and places that make it special.

"In addition to honoring the town and its 150th birthday, we want to get more community involvement," she said. "Get to know your neighbor as well as celebrate our history."

Q: True or False: Nicholson was home to the first telephone service in Northeastern Pennsylvania

A: True. In 1878, the area's first telephone line ran between the DL&W railroad station in Scranton to the station in Nicholson (now home of the Nicholson Tourism Center).

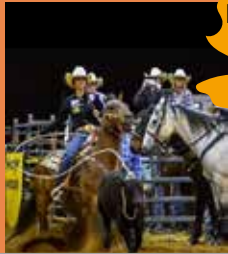
